### THIS PERMIT ISSUED SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. This permit grants to the permittee those rights specifically stated and no other.
2. Issuance of this permit does not relieve the permittee from meeting any and all requirements with other public bodies or agencies.
3. The permittee shall save harmless the Friends of the Trail, and all officers, and agents thereof, against any and all claims arising from operations covered by this permit.
4. Assignments will be made on a first come basis. Group must agree to pickup litter a minimum of (3) times a year, during designated dates in April, July and October. All workdays are to be scheduled with the Macomb Orchard Trail Adopt a Trail Coordinator to insure availability of needed equipment and the availability of needed resources.
5. This permit expires after 1 year. Groups may renew the permit.
6. Groups failing to follow the guidelines or not participating in trash pickup for two periods of the year will have their permit revoked.
7. The group must consist of 10 or more persons and maintain at least (10) persons throughout the permit period. Crew leader/group contact person must be identified above. Identification of original proposed group by name, address, and phone is requested. The Friends of the Macomb Orchard Trail must approve changes in the contact person(s). Persons in the group may change without notification.
8. Volunteer groups must consist of at least (10) people who are 18 years of age or older, unless the volunteer group is a school or scout organization in which case the volunteer(s) may be under 18 years of age.
9. Participants must hold a safety meeting once a year prior to the first pickup, conducted by the adopting group with provided safety tips used as a guideline.
10. All trash must be placed in bags. Those objects too large or heavy shall be placed next to the bags. Full bags are to be placed in designated locations for pickup. No personal household trash of group members will be accepted.
11. The county will supply a sign recognizing your group's participation in the program. The Friends of the Trail shall retain the right to revoke any permit at any time. The permittee, upon request of the Friends of the Trail, shall immediately cease operations and surrender this permit. Issuance of a permit and/or participation in the ADOPT-A- TRAIL program does not indicate Friends of the Trail supports or endorses any organization or position.
